Our Hypothesis

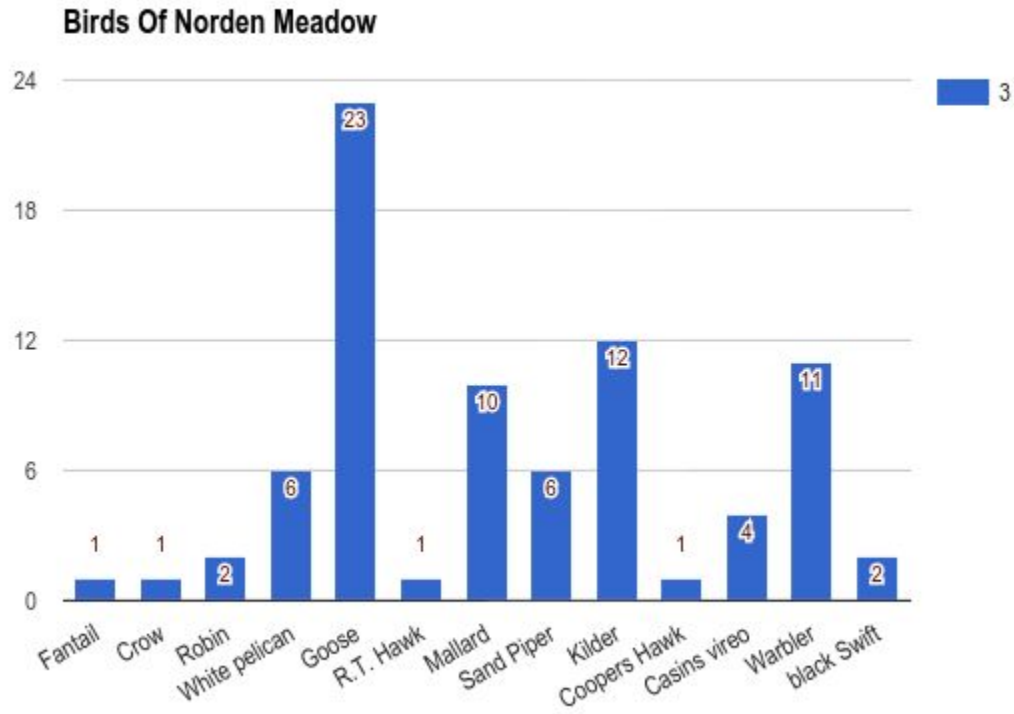
There will be more predatory birds like hawks and eagles than any other type of bird because there would be more rodents in an open meadow.



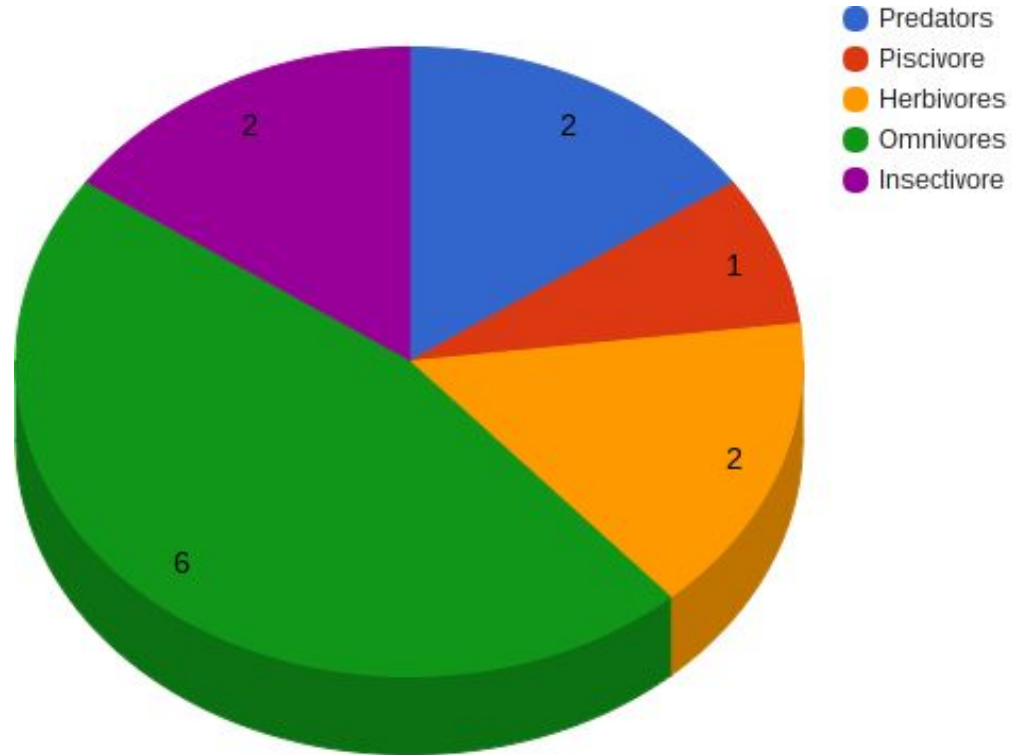
Our Methods
