



## Headwaters Science Institute Summer Media Internship

Headwaters Science Institute is a non-profit specializing in science education whose primary focus is to give students and teachers the tools to conduct independent scientific research. Headwaters is looking for a summer intern for 2017 to assist with a few multimedia projects. This internship will range from 10-20 hours a week and be at minimum 55 hours. The position would work alongside Headwaters staff for at least half of the time.

### **Projects:**

The primary project of this internship will be to work with Headwaters employees to assemble a short video (60-120 seconds) describing the educational experience we provide students. Footage from our spring student programs will be provided, however, additional footage audio may need to be captured. The goal of this video to improve upon our previous video (<https://youtu.be/qdtsZXuZ58g>) that we use to walk prospective students and teachers through the process we use to help students design independent scientific research projects. Specific tasks would include video editing, sound editing, filming, script writing and script editing.

This position will also help generate content for newsletters and social media. The intern will work with Headwaters staff to create newsletter and social media content from both our photo library and photos they generate. Specific tasks would include writing, editing, photography, and photo editing.

Headwaters will put on a couple fundraising events during the summer for which the intern will provide some assistance. This would include helping setup for events and tabling informational booths.
